Edna was returning from her errand of taking rice, beans, and oil to an elderly widow, when she heard someone call out to her. Turning, she saw a young father surrounded by several children. He had seen her carrying the food and asked if she could spare some for the family. It is well known in town that Edna, as a representative of the House of Hope mission, does what she can to alleviate the effects of poverty and food scarcity on the families in the community.

When Edna asked for approval to help this family, our response was yes, of course. We also wondered if the children were enrolled in school. Edna enquired further, and found that though the kids did not attend, they would love to go if they could afford it. Books, uniforms, and tuition payments are prohibitive costs for many Haitian families that would otherwise educate their children.

When they were told that we would find sponsors for them to pay these costs if they attended our school, they were eager to enroll. Annie, our school sponsorship program coordinator, quickly found willing sponsors, and we are now working with the family to register the kids for school. The parents now have hope that their children will have a better life.

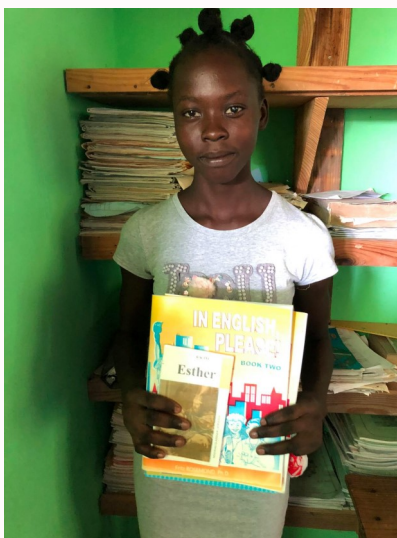
